Bautizos

Las platicas para los bautizos son cada ultimo domingo del mes, despues de la misa. Los bautizos se haran cada primer sabado del mes. Para mas informacion, llamar a la oficina.

Queridos feligreses:

Hoy, solemnidad del Bautismo del Señor, termina el ciclo de las fiestas de Navidad. Dice el Evangelio que Juan se había presentado en el desierto y «predicaba un bautismo de conversión para el perdón de los pecados» (Mc 1,4). La gente iba a escucharlo, confesaban sus pecados y se hacían bautizar por él en el río Jordán. Y entre aquellas gentes se presentó también Jesús para ser bautizado.

En las fiestas de Navidad hemos visto como Jesús se manifestaba a los pastores y a los magos que, llegando desde Oriente, lo adoraron y le ofrecieron sus dones. De hecho, la venida de Jesús al mundo es para manifestar el amor de Dios que nos salva.

Y allí, en el Jordán, se produjo una nueva manifestación de la divinidad de Jesús: el cielo se abrió y el Espíritu Santo, en forma de paloma descendía hacia Él y se oyó la voz del Padre: «Tú eres mi Hijo amado, en ti me complazco» (Mc 1,11). Es el Padre del cielo en este caso y el Espíritu Santo quienes lo manifiestan. Es Dios mismo que nos revela quién es Jesús, su Hijo amado.

Pero no era una revelación sólo para Juan y los judíos. Era también para nosotros. El mismo Jesús, el Hijo amado del Padre, manifestado a los judíos en el Jordán, se manifiesta continuamente a nosotros cada día. En la Iglesia, en la oración, en los hermanos, en el Bautismo que hemos recibido y que nos ha hecho hijos del mismo Padre.

Hermanos y hermanas, la cantidad de tiempo, talento y tesoro que decidimos compartir con los demás, nuestra parroquia, los pobres y todos aquellos que necesitan nuestra ayuda generalmente corresponde a qué tan bien entendemos y aceptamos que todo lo que somos, tenemos y podemos hacer es un regalo inmerecido de Dios. Ayúdanos a crecer como familia parroquial durante este año de 2021, dedicado a San José, el buen administrador de la gracia de Dios.

Nuestra Señora de la Paz, ruega por nosotros.

Dear Parishioners:

Today, with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, the Christmas cycle is over. The Gospel says that John had «appeared in the wilderness, preaching a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of the sins» (Mk 1:4). People went out to see and hear him, to confess their sins and to be baptized by him in the Jordan River. And among those people Jesus also appeared to be baptized.

At Christmas we have seen how Jesus appeared to the shepherds and the magi who, coming from the East, worshiped Him and offered Him their gifts. In fact, the coming of Jesus to the world is to manifest God's love that saves us.

And there, in the river Jordan, a new manifestation of Jesus' divinity was made: heaven was opened, and the Holy Spirit descended towards Him as a dove and the voice of the Father was heard: «You are my Son, whom I love; with you I am well pleased» (Mk 1:11). In this case, it is the Father of Heaven and the Holy Spirit who made it manifest. It is God himself who reveals who is Jesus, His beloved son.

But it was not a revelation only for John and the Jews. It was for us too. Jesus himself, the beloved Son of the Father, who manifested to the Jews in the river Jordan, continually manifests to us every day. In the Church, in prayers, in our brothers, at the Baptism we have received that has made us children of the same Father.

Brothers and sisters, the amount of time, talent, and treasure we decide to share with others, our parish, and the poor and all those who need our help usually corresponds to how well we understand and accept that all we are, have and can do is an undeserved gift from God. Please help us to grow as a parish family during this year of 2021, dedicated to Saint Joseph the good steward of God's grace.
